

Fred J. Miller Summer Clinic Staff Application Requirements

Individuals interested in becoming a member of the FJM summer clinic staff must complete the application and audition process described below. Applicants who do not live in or around the Dayton area may complete the alternative application process.

Application Process

1. Live auditions will be held at the Miamisburg, Ohio FJM office where applicants will complete the following (appropriate performance/rehearsal attire, rather than interview attire, is permitted):

- .. Approximately 2 minute performance in all sections for which you apply
- .. 10-15 minute teaching demonstration in sections for which you apply
- .. 30 minute interview

* Travel expenses are the responsibility of the applicant

2. Submit a completed application form, with references, to the Clinic Coordinator. Auditions will be scheduled after application is received.

3. Submit a resume of your pageantry, performance, and teaching experiences

Alternative Process (for out-of-state applicants)

1. Submit a recording (DVD) of the following:

- .. Approximately 2 minute performance in all sections for which you apply (no full band/group performances, please)
- .. 10-15 minute teaching demonstration in sections for which you apply
- .. Explanation of why you would like to be selected for the FJM summer clinic staff

2. Submit a completed application form, with references, to the Clinic Coordinator

3. Submit a resume of your pageantry, performance, and teaching, experiences

4. Submit a wallet size photo of yourself
